- 6) From here you can print the page or, if you prefer, save the document as a PDF. If you wish to save the document as a PDF, select the "Destination" dropdown menu and click "Save as PDF." Your print button will change from "Print" to "Save." Otherwise you can just press "Print" to print the document.
- 7) If you are obtaining this to use as part of a permit application, be sure to draw in your proposed work as close to scale as possible before sending it in for review. This drawing should include important measurements such as dimensions of the structure being built and distances from property lines, so we can assure conformance with our Zoning Regulations.
