Article V – Supplementary Regulations

Section 5.13.3 Minimum Acceptable Standards:

- (1) Plans for soil erosion and sediment control shall be developed in accordance with these regulations using the principles as outlined in the <u>Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control</u> 2002, as amended. Soil erosion and sediment control plans shall result in a development that minimizes erosion and sedimentation during construction; is stabilized and protected from erosion when completed; and does not cause off site erosion and/or sedimentation.
- (2) The minimum standards for individual measures are those in the <u>Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control</u> 2002, as amended. The Board (or Southwest Conservation District) may grant exceptions when requested by the applicant if technically sound reasons are presented.
- (3) The appropriate method from the <u>Connecticut Guidelines for Soil</u> <u>Erosion and Sediment Control</u> 2002, as amended, shall be used.
