Lead Education for Homeowners

Dangers of Lead

- Lead poisoning can lead to symptoms like:
 - Intestinal cramps
 - Severe fatigue
 - Peripheral nerve damage
 - Anemia
- High levels of exposure can lead to more permanent effects such as:
 - Neurological damage
 - Renal damage
 - Cardiovascular damage
 - Death

Lead is often in the paint of older homes. That paint often flakes off over time and ends up in our soil, yards, and playgrounds.

How to Manage Lead Levels in Your Home

and animals, causing

- Place dust mats inside and outside entryways.
- Wipe and remove shoes before entering your home to keep lead dust out of the home.
- Wash hands after playing or working outside.
- Plant bushes and plants near the house to discourage kids from playing in exposed soil.
- Inspect and keep all painted surfaces well-maintained.
- Consult a certified lead professional before starting any renovations, repairs, or painting projects.

Healthy Homes

Working with a team of licensed and certified experts, the program assesses homes and develops a scope of work to address housing-related health hazards, such as lead-based paint, mold, asbestos, and injury risks" -CCMC





Community Development Block Grant

This funding is an entitlement grant funded by the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The program is designed to provide eligible Milford homeowners with an affordable way to improve accessibility, and energy efficiency and reduce overall housing costs, including but not limited to leadbased paint testing and stabilization.
