F. ARBORETUM

• Dutch Elm Disease – Bryan Mancini received a letter from Chris Donnelly, Urban Forester for the State of Connecticut. Kate Orecchio had called him regarding the Elm Preservation Society. There are 4 Elms that have contracted this disease, and are almost dead. Mr. Connelly's letter indicated that samples be taken from the infected trees and sent to the Ct Dept. of Agriculture to confirm that what is causing the infection is Dutch Elm Disease. The Elm Preservation Society is where these 4 trees came from and are evidently guaranteed, so their replacements should be forthcoming. Bryan Mancini will be sending a letter to Public Works requesting that immediate action be taken to remove these trees, that they be chipped and all wood be removed and sent to the transfer station to be burned, as

but for the diseased wood there are also insects infested in the wood that can infect the other healthy trees.

This request seems to be acceptable. Bryan Mancini will write the letter.
