We can still not answer any questions, and can not accept any use of building requests until this gets all straightened out. Air conditioner still has no power, roof is still not fixed, downstairs door is still not fixed, and front door is still broken.

New Business: A motion was made by Greg Smith that any group that is an authorized resident of the Fowler Memorial Building can have use of the building anytime that is needed as long as it is not already in use by another group, 2nd by John D'Amico, accepted. Letter was written to Public Works thanking them for all they do.
